Every year in September, to create our own local Day of Peace, we host an annual event right here in Southwest Florida, at Jaycee Park in Cape Coral called "Peace Day in the Park". This year we are thrilled to be celebrating our "9th Annual Peace Day in the Park"! Each year our local community has come together to celebrate a Day of Peace, and each year the numbers of people who want to become involved, and who just want to be there to enjoy the experience, has grown and grown! In 2010 we met with Cape Coral mayor, John Sullivan, who issued a Proclamation of Peace, publicly recognizing Peace Day here in our local community, to be observed annually in support of Peace One Day! Last year, our current Mayor, Marni Dilsaver Sawicki, took the Proclamation to the next level, acknowledging the growing support for the observance of the International Day of Peace within our city, and declaring that September 21st IS The International Day of Peace in the City of Cape Coral! She urges all government departments to commemorate the International Day of Peace to help establish a global day of peace in our homes, schools, communities and between nations! Last year, the News Press reported that up to 10,000 people joined us in Jaycee Park. Throughout the years, we have collected literally tons of food in our Food drive to help people right here in our local community. Our blood drive is amazing, and has people lining up to donate blood...all of which stays right here to help people in our local community! A truly peaceful, magical and unforgettable experience!

One individual can, and does, make a difference! In the words of Gandhi, "We must be the Change we wish to see in the world"... and it starts in our own back yard.
